- May 3 & 4 @ 6:30 PM and 7:30 PM—Civil War Williamsburg Walking Tour. Join the WBA on a 1-hour walking tour of the historic area of Williamsburg. You will learn what the town was like on the eve of Civil War and what it experienced during and after the May 5, 1862 battle. Meet your licensed tour guide at the east end of Duke of Gloucester Street in front of the restored Capitol building (500 E. Duke of Gloucester St.).
- May 4 @ 9 AM to Noon—Battlefield Pop-Up Tours. Join the WBA at four separate sites on the battlefield for an interpretation of what occurred there on May 5, 1862. The sites are Redoubt Park, the Williamsburg Area Transit Authority (WATA) facility, the Fort Magruder historic site, and New Quarter Park's Visitor Center. 
Give Local 757—May 14, 2019

Smith Tract Update

The WBA continues to make positive progress toward final acquisition of the almost 4-acre Smith Tract in York County from the American Battlefield Trust (ABT). Before accepting transfer of the property, which has a conservation easement on it, we desire to understand if we can receive tax relief on the property from the County. A reduction in property taxes will allow us to focus our resources on improving the parcel, encouraging visitation, and working on a plan for access and interpretation. We have made formal application to York County for tax remediation and subsequently responded in writing to several questions raised by the County regarding our intended use of the property. The ABT is following and supporting us in this process. We anticipate a public hearing with York County sometime later in the spring or summer to further present our plans for the Smith Tract to County officials and residents.

In the meantime, the WBA is fulfilling a stewardship role for the Smith Tract by participating in the ABT's annual Park Day, which was held earlier this month and was attended by about 30 volunteers from the community who helped pick-up trash, trim trees and bushy plants, and remove excess organic debris.
